




Open the battery door.



Insert 2 AAA batteries.

TELEVISION and FREEVIEW

Select control of your TV or Freeview/ Freesat Box

WATCH TV

This key allows you combine control of your Freeview Box and your TV. In this mode you can control the Volume and AV Input of your TV and the other keys will all control the Freeview Box.

POWER

On/Off. In Watch TV Mode, holding down this key for 3 seconds will turn the TV and Freeview Box off.




STEP 1: SET UP YOUR TELEVISION

START WITH YOUR BRAND NUMBER: IS YOUR TV BRAND LISTED?

YES: SIMPLESET

Turn on your TV (not standby).
Point remote towards the TV.



Press and release the TV key. Hold down the SETUP key until the TV key blinks twice.



Press and release the BRAND NUMBER, e.g number 4 for Panasonic. Next press and hold the OK key until the TV switches off. RELEASE the key as soon as your television switches off. The remote will now operate your TV. If you find that some keys operate incorrectly or not at all, repeat from Step 1 to find the next code.

FINISH


Go to step 2: Set up your Set Top Box, on the next page.

NO: DIRECT SET

Locate the brand of your TV in the codelist overleaf.



Press and release the TV key. Hold down the SETUP key until the TV key blinks twice.



Enter the first Code listed for your Brand. LED will blink twice. Point towards TV and press power. If TV switches off you are ready. If not repeat the procedure using next code.

FINISH


If Direct Set didn't work, go to step 3: Auto Search

STEP 2: SET UP YOUR SET TOP BOX

START WITH YOUR BRAND NUMBER: IS YOUR BRAND LISTED BELOW?

YES: SIMPLESET

Turn on your STB (not standby).
Point remote towards the STB.



Press and release the FREEVIEW key. Then hold down the SETUP key until the Freeview key blinks twice.




Enter the 2 Digit BRAND NUMBER, e.g number 06 for Amstrad. Next press and hold the OK key until the Set Top Box switches off. RELEASE the key as soon as your Freeview/Freesat box switches off. The remote will now operate your Set Top Box. If you find that some keys operate incorrectly or not at all, repeat from Step 1 to find the next code.

FINISH

If Simpleset didn't work, go to Direct Set

NO: DIRECT SET

Locate the brand of your Set Top Box in the codelist overleaf.



Press and release the FREEVIEW key. Then hold down the SETUP key until the Freeview key blinks twice.



Enter the first Code listed for your Brand. LED will blink twice. Point towards STB and press power. If STB switches off you are ready. If not repeat the procedure using next code.

FINISH

If Direct Set didn't work, go to step 3: Auto Search

STEP 3: AUTO SEARCH (IF SIMPLESET OR DIRECT SET DOES NOT WORK)

START: CHOOSE TV OR FREEVIEW

TV



Press and release the TV key. Then hold down the SETUP key until the TV key blinks twice.



Point the remote at your TV. Press and hold the POWER key. The remote will send a different Power signal to your TV every 3 seconds. As soon as the TV switches off, release the Power key to store the code. The LED will blink twice, and the remote should now operate your TV. If you find that some keys operate incorrectly or not at all, repeat from Step 1 to find the next code.

This may take up to 15 minutes.

FINISH

FREEVIEW



Press and release the FREEVIEW key. Then hold down the SETUP key until the Freeview key blinks twice.



Point the remote at your Freeview/ Freesat box. Press and hold the Power key. The remote will send a different Power signal to your box every 3 seconds. As soon as the Set Top Box switches off, release the Power key to store the code. The LED will blink twice, and the remote should now operate your box. If you find that some keys operate incorrectly or not at all, repeat from Step 1 to find the next code.

This may take up to 15 minutes.


STEP 4: COPY LEARN FUNCTION

START: LEARN A NEW FUNCTION TO YOUR REMOTE


Your One For All remote can learn any function from your original (working) remote.




Place the original remote facing the One For All remote on a flat surface.



Press the key for the mode you want to learn functions in - e.g TV. Press and hold the Setup key until the Mode LED blinks twice.



Press 975. The LED will blink twice.




Press the key on the One For All remote you want to learn on, for Example: the red key



Press the key on the Original remote you want to learn, for Example: the TOP MENU



Two blinks: ok. Repeat from step 4 for any more keys to learn. Long blink: try again from step 4.



When you have learned all the keys you need, press and hold the SETUP key for 3 seconds. The Mode LED will blink twice.

HOW TO DELETE A LEARNED FUNCTION

1. Press the key for the mode you want to delete functions from - e.g. TV
2. Hold down the SETUP key until the Mode LED blinks twice
3. Press the key you wish to delete (e.g. the Red key) twice. The Mode LED will blink twice.
